

Fruit Fly Chemical Provided

These terms and conditions apply to properties within a Riverland fruit fly Outbreak Area under the Plant Health Act 2009 (the Act).

As you may be aware, the Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development (the Minister) has declared by notice dated 26 April 2022 (published in the Government Gazette dated 5 May 2022 at pages 1052-1056), certain measures for the treatment of fruit fly in a fruit fly outbreak area.

The chemical is provided on the following terms and conditions:

- you must provide a property map, including an accurate calculation of the area (in hectares) where the chemical provided to you will be used
- you must only use fruit fly chemical products provided to you by the Minister as directed
- it is desirable that you provide evidence of Chemical training when you collect any bait
- you must return to the Department of Primary Industries and Regions any unused fruit fly chemical provided to you by the Minister, unless otherwise authorised in writing
- a record must be completed and maintained as directed by the Minister detailing the application of any fruit fly chemical products provided to you by the Minister
- you must provide details of the chemical application record to PIRSA by emailing fruitfly@sa.gov.au in an approved format or delivering a hard copy to the PIRSA Barmera office located at 52 Field Day Drive, Barmera, commencing within 7 days of applying fruit fly chemical products
- by agreeing to participate, you agree that your property details will be shared with the relevant industry for the purpose of identifying areas that are not being baited.

Please note:

The provision of chemical does not permit the movement of fruit or automatically count towards any Market Access systems approach accreditation.

For the eradication efforts to be maximised, growers are asked to apply bait for a minimum of six weeks even if their harvest has finished for the season. If you are yet to, or still in, harvest you must continue to bait at the rates and frequencies prescribed in the relevant systems approach Operational Procedure until your harvest is complete.
